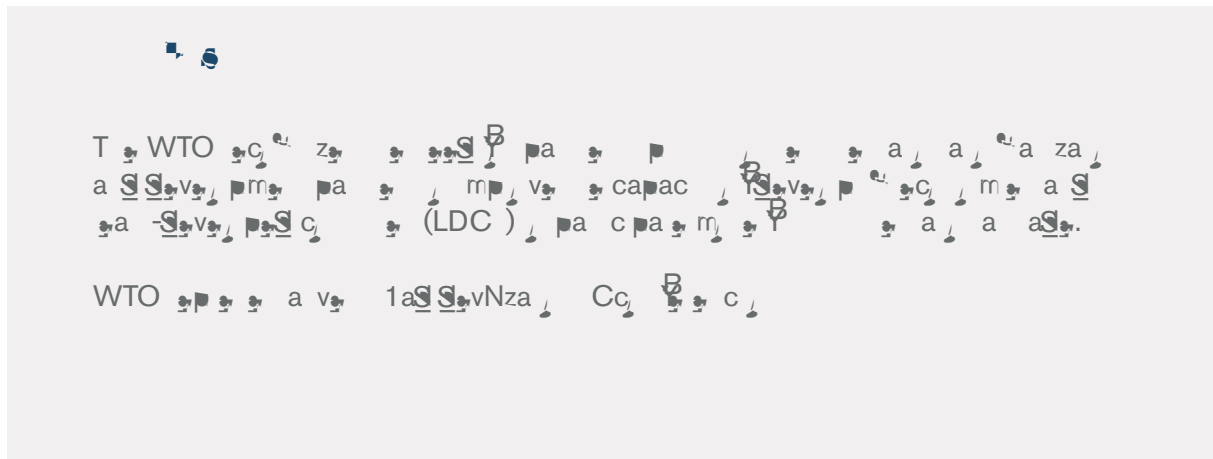


SD 17: Partnership for Sustainable Development
