Article 29

Transformation into a Market Economy

- 29.1 Members in the process of transformation from a centrally -planned into a market, free-enterprise economy may apply programmes and measures necessar y for such a transformation.
- 29.2 For such Members, subsidy programmes falling within the scope of Article 3, and notified according to paragraph 3, shall be phased out or brought into conformity with Article 3 within a period of seven years from the dat e of entry into force of the WTO Agreement. In such a case, Article 4 shall not apply. In addition during the same period:
 - (a) Subsidy programmes falling within the scope of paragraph 1(d) of Article 6 shall not be actionable under Article 7:
 - (b) With respect to other actionable subsidies, the provisions of paragraph 9 of Article 27 shall apply.
- 29.3 Subsidy programmes falling within the scope of Article 3 shall be notified to the Committee by the earliest practicable date after the date of entry in a to for ce of the WTO Agreement. Further notifications of such subsidies may be made up to two years after the date of entry into force of the WTO Agreement.
- 29.4 In exceptional circumstances Members referred to in paragraph 1 may be given departures from their notified programmes and measures and their time -frame by the Committee if such departures are deemed necessary for the process of transformation.

1.2 General
