

Critical information infrastructure protection (CIIP) – ex. cable links, routers, data centres

Cybersecurity - how


Norms (binding and non-binding): standards of behavior, defining rights and obligations

Confidence building measures (CBMs): measures to encourage cooperation and reduce the risk of conflict




