

GLOBAL AND REGIONAL PERFORMANCE



World trade of commercial services¹ increased by 0.3% in the third quarter of 2019 compared to the previous quarter, as measured in seasonally adjusted terms.



1. Average of exports and imports. Source: WTO-UNCTAD-ITC


Services trade was f at or declined in Q3 2019. Europe recorded the strongest rise in exports among regions, **1.4%**, while imports decreased **-1.2%**. North America's exports were f at (**+0.2%**) while imports increased slightly (**+1.0%**) compared to the previous quarter. Asian services exports were essentially unchanged quarter-over-quarter, while imports grew **0.9%**.

SECTORAL PERFORMANCE

All sectors experienced a decline in trade in Q3 except other comm. services (**0.5%**). Goods-related services and transport fell the most, (-**1.7%**, -**0.6%**) as trade tensions impacted merchandise trade.
