

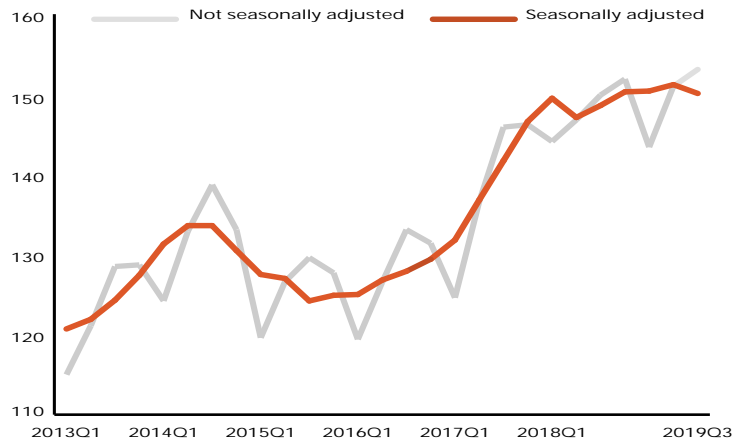
GLOBAL AND REGIONAL PERFORMANCE

0.3%

World trade of commercial services¹ increased by 0.3% in the third quarter of 2019 compared to the previous quarter, as measured in seasonally adjusted terms.

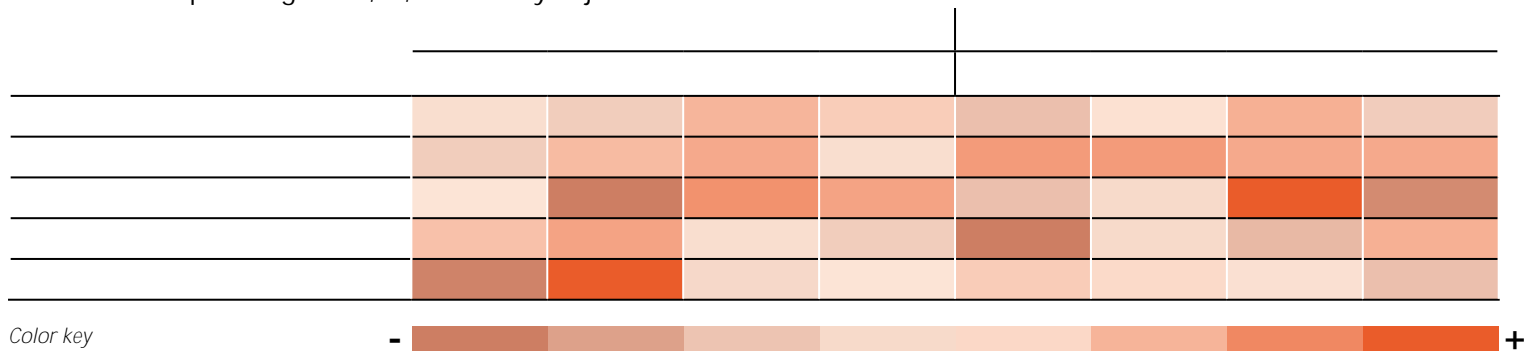

Services trade was flat or declined in Q3 2019. Europe recorded the strongest rise in exports among regions, **1.4%**, while imports decreased **-1.2%**. North America's exports were flat (**+0.2%**) while imports increased slightly (**+1.0%**) compared to the previous quarter. Asian services exports were essentially unchanged quarter-over-quarter, while imports grew **0.9%**.

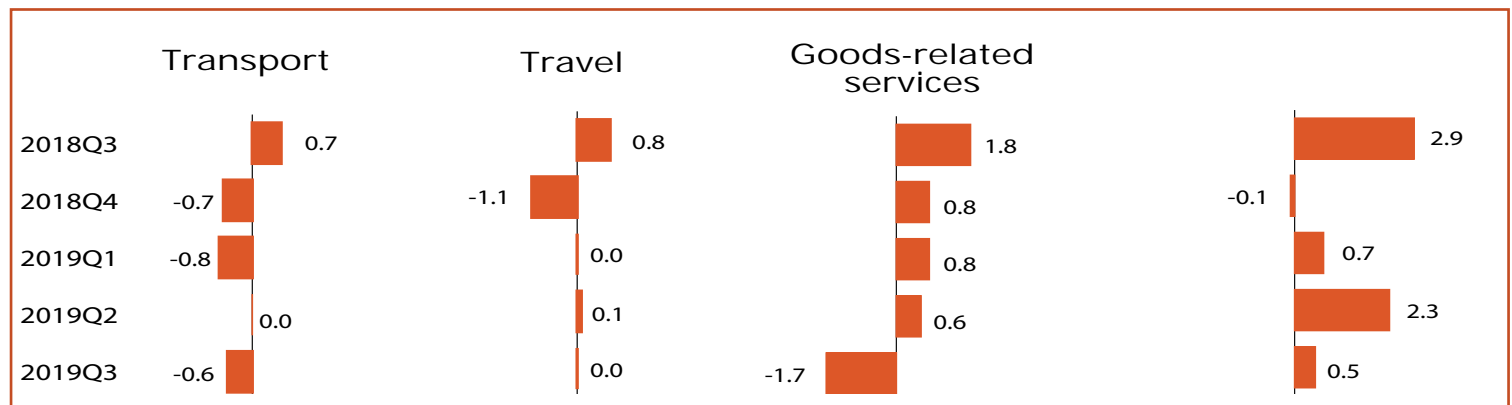
Quarter-over-quarter growth, %, seasonally adjusted

SECTORAL PERFORMANCE

All sectors experienced a decline in trade in Q3 except other comm. services (**0.5%**). Goods-related services and transport fell the most, (**-1.7%**, **-0.6%**) as trade tensions impacted merchandise trade.
