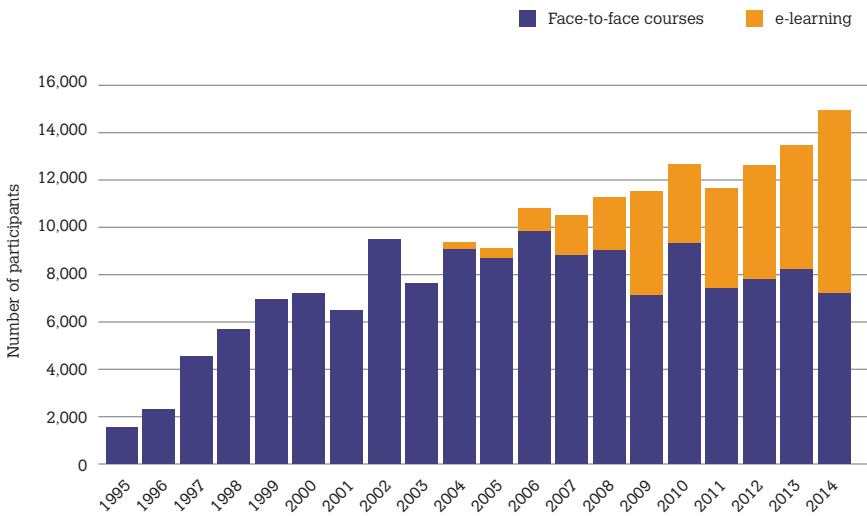

Figure 1: Participants in training activities



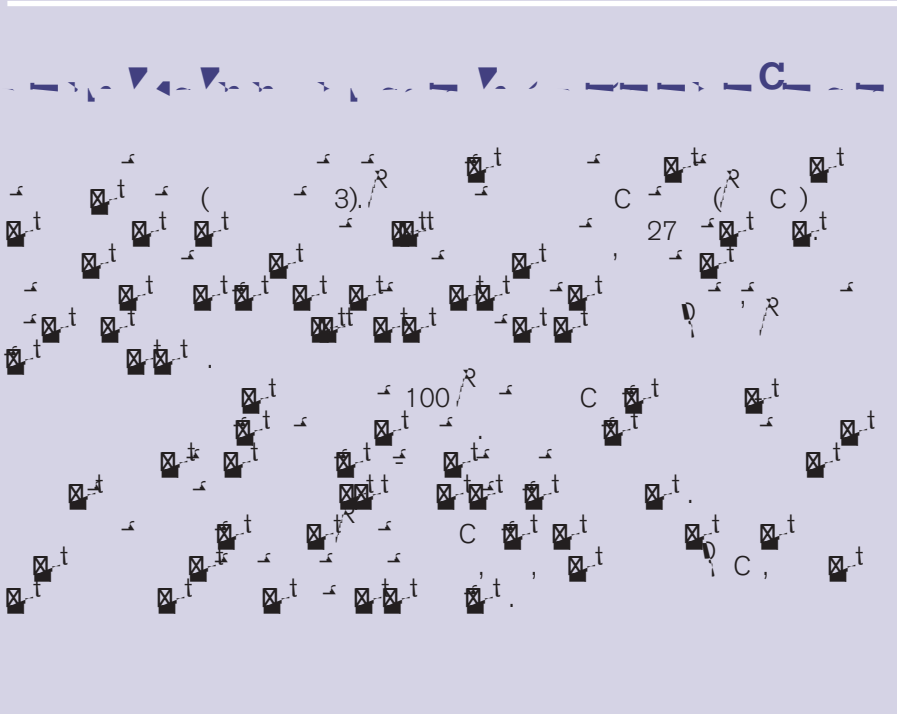
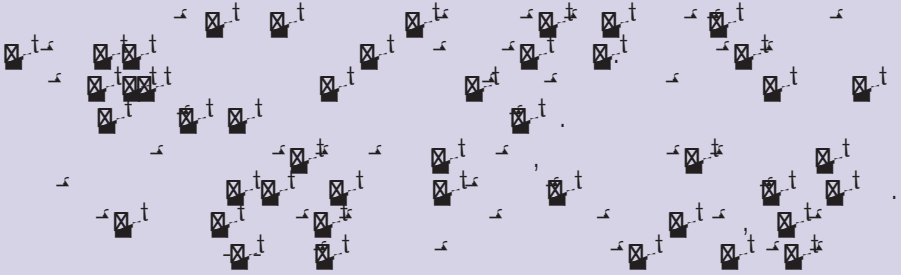


Figure 3: Regional trade policy courses hosted by WTO members, e-learning participation and Reference Centres in LDCs



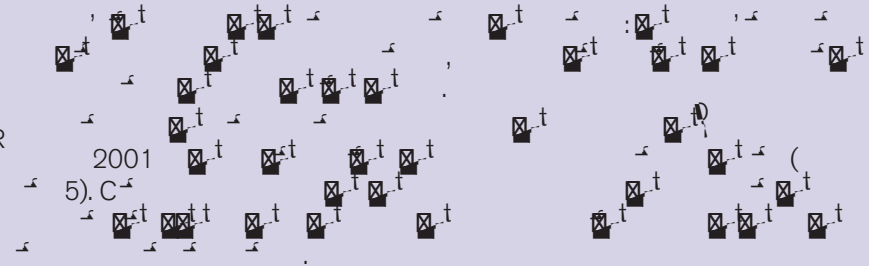


Figure 5: Funding for WTO training activities

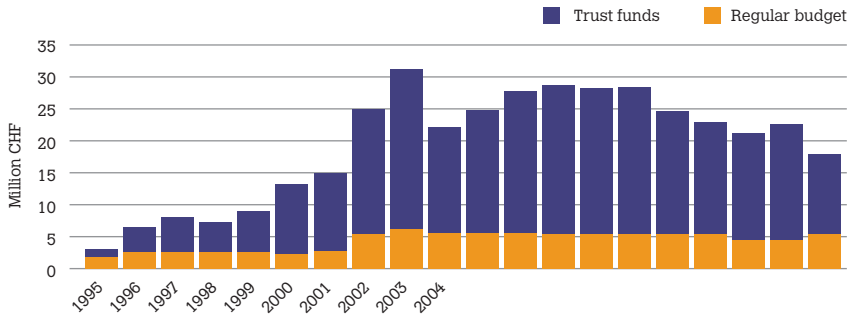
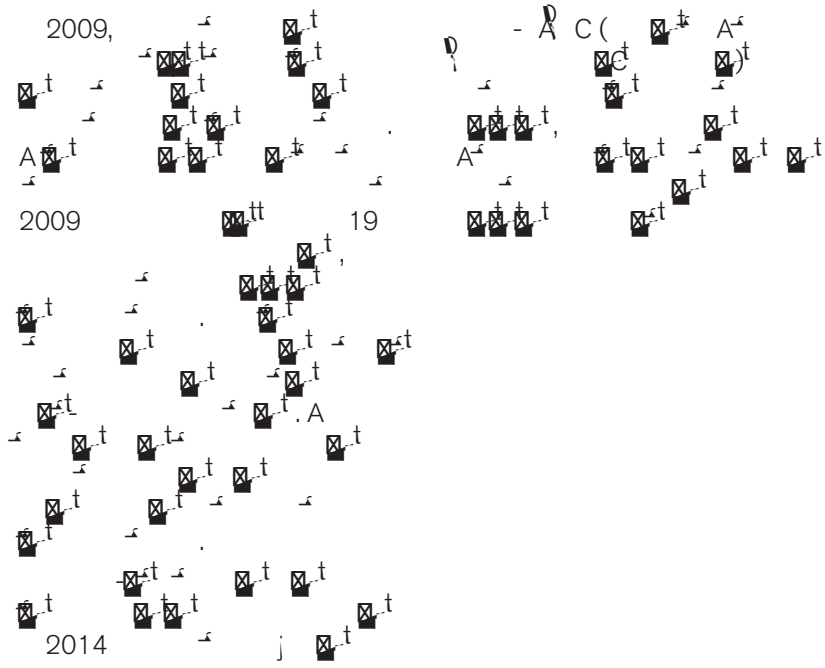
