


WTO Accessions results to date

0 Tde[(rimo)-4.4 (n)9.7 (th)2.2 (*)]TJ/TT0 1 Tft

- 34 36 accessions, including from 9 LDCs, have been concluded between 1996 and 2016
 - Last Members joined in July2016, i.e. Afghanistarand Liberia
 - Article XIIMembersaccountfor over 20% of WTO membership
 - Additional 18% of world trade coveredby WTOrules today, 98.1% world trade conducted under WTO
 - %Averagelength of accession 10 years and 2 months (but 12 years and 2 months for LDCs)
 - Shortest 2 years and 8 months (KyrgyzRepublic,1998)
 - Longest 19 years and 9 months (Kazakhstaand Seychelles 2015)
 - 3/43 African Accessions concluded to date:
 - Cabo Verde* (joined in July2008) 8 yead
