Pursuant to Article 291 paragraph 3 of toustoms Law ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro", No. 07/028/02, 72/02, 21/03, 31/029/05 i 66/06), the Government of the Republic of Montenegro enacts the following

D E C R E E ON THE TYPES, AMOUNTS AND MA NNER OF PAYMENT OF FEE FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY CUSTOMS AUTHORITIES

Article 1

This Decree determines the types, amounted manner of payment of fee for the services rendered by customs authorities (hand after referred to as: customs fee).

Article 2

Customs fee for the services of customs autities shall be paid for the following:

- 1) for processing of summary declaration;
- 2) for processing of single customs decliara (here and after referred to as: JCI) or other document submitted instead of JCI;
- 3) for issuance of binding information the classification of goods under the Customs Tariff:
- 4) for issuance of binding infonation on the origin of goods;
- 5) for processing expenses connection with requess for the protection of intellectual property rights at the border;
- 6) for calculation of the customs debt **tole**arance of goods to **bre**lased into free circulation;
- 7) expenses for on-site activities by anthanized customs officer for the purposes of placing goods under customs superisand customs clearance outside places and premises where customs authority uterly performs customs supervision, control and clearance of goods;
- 8) expenses for on-site activities by **au**thorized customs officer after working hours of customs authorities for performancectivities referred to in paragraph 1, item 7 of this Article.

Article 3

Customs fee for processing of summary **atesti**on shall be of 2 Euros per customs declaration.

Customs fee for process; of JCI shall be:

For JCI containing up to 4 tariff items- 2 Euros

For JCI containing from 5 up to 14 tariff items- 3 Euros, and

For JCI containing more than 14 tariff items- 5 Euros.

Customs fee referred to inishArticle shall be paid inprocedure of temporary storage of goods and in customs procedures, and pitalish together with submitted summary declaration or JCI.

Article 4

Customs fee for issuance of binding imfration on the classification of goods according to the Customs Tariff and for a binding information on the origin of goods shall be 100 Euros.

Customs fee for processing expenses in **eotion** with requests for the protection of intellectual property rights at the border shall be 100 Euros.

Customs fee referred to in paragraph 1 and the information of intellectual property rights at the border.

Customs fee referred to in paragraph 1, 23a noth this Article shall be payable based upon a specific type of goods.

Article 5

Customs fee for calculation of the customstder clearance of goods to be released into free circulation shall be 2 Euros.

Article 6

Customs fee for expenses for on-site acitistiby an authorized customs officer for the purposes of placing goods der customs supervision and customs clearance outside places and premises where customathority regularly performs customs supervision, control and clearance of goods lb Euros for each initiated hour of work of the authorized customs officer.

Customs fee for expenses ton-site activities by an authized customs officer after working hours of customs authorities fperformance of activities referred to in paragraph 1 of this Articleshall be 5 Euros for each inaited hour of work of the authorized customs officer.

Article 7

On the day this Decree comes into the Fee for Services Rendered by Custo Anuthorities (Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro, No. 20/03, 62/04 25/40/05) shall cease to be effective.

Article 8

This Decree shall come into force eight days after the day of its publishing in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro".
