By virtue of paragraph 3 Article0 of the Veterinary Law ("Offial Gazette of RM" No. 11/04),

the Government of the Republic of Mentegro, at its session held on the July 2003, passed this

DECISION

ON THE LEVEL OF COMPENSATION FOR VETERINARY-SANITARY CONTROL IN THE TRADE ACROSS THE BORDER OF THE REPUBLIC OF MONTENGRO

Article 1

This decision regulates the level of the compensation for mandatory veterinary-sanitary control at the border crossings of the Reblic of Montenegro, in exptyr import, and transit of the consignments of animals, foodstuffs, raw made; products, animalobdstuffs, and wastes of animal origin.

- 1. Level of the compensation for consignmentsy truck, railway wagon, ship, container, or by air is as follows:
 - a) for consignments of equine and cloven-headanimals in the transport unit, in the case of:
 - export of up to 10 tons net mass EUR 5.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity – EUR 1.00;
 - import of up to 10 tons net massEUR 20.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity EUR 3.00;
 - transit of up to 10 tons net mass EU5.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity EUR 2.00;
 - b) for consignments of poultry, birds, rabbilitares, and game, and apes for laboratory examinations, in the transport unit, in the case of:
 - export of up to 5 tons net mass EUR 5.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity – EUR 1.00;
 - import of up to 5 tons net mass EUR 20.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity – EUR 3.00;
 - transit of up to 5 tons net mass —歷切5.00 and thereafter for each following ton or any part of such quantity EUR 2.00;

c)	for consignments of one day old poultry (ckein, turkey, geese, ducks, etc.)	in the
	transport unit, in the case of:	

transit– EUR 15.00;

b)

the border to examine the consignment and theeirtop comes to the place of examination at the arranged time, the importer, experitor transiter, or their repsentative, shall pay EUR 15.00 for each hour of keeping the inspector on hold.

Article 6

The level of compensation for the veterinary-sanitary control referred to in Article 1, items 1 to 3 of this Decision, if conducted oxide the inspectors' working hoxirat night, on non-working days or statutory holidays, the level of respensation shall be increased by 50%.

The work at night, in the context of paragraph this Article, shall be construed to mean the work between 22:00 and 06:00.

Article 7

In the event that veterinary-sanitary contion conducted outside the veterinary inspection registered office, the transportation costs inequiriby the veterinary inspector who have conducted the control shall be paid separately.

Article 8

Compensation for mandatory veiteary-sanitary control shalle paid by the applicant.

The compensation referred to in paragraph 1 of Athiss le shall be paid to the incoming payment account of the budget of the Republic Montenegro, No. -832 -6142 -07.

Article 9

On the day of coming into force of this Decisionrovisions of Article 4paragraph 2, 3 and 5, and Articles 8 and 9 of the Decision of Level of Compensation for the Evel of Animals, and Products, Raw Materials and Wasfesnimal Origin in the Production and on the Market ("Official Gazete of RM" No. 51/2003).

Article 10

This Decision shall come into force on the eighthy after its publication in the "Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro".
