

THE LAW ON INTERNAL TRADE

Article 1

This Law shall regulate internal trade (hereinafter referred to as: trade) requirements for and forms of trade, protection from unfair business practices and supervision of the implementation of this Law.

Article 2

For the purposes of this Law, the trade shall mean purchase and sale of goods and provision of trade related services.

Article 3

Any commercial entity and any entrepreneur (hereinafter referred to as: the trader) shall be entitled to trade.

The draft Law on Internal Trade, approved by the Government, provides, *inter alia*, for the right of natural persons (entrepreneurs) to engage in any kind of trade, both wholesale and retail. This translation comprises only the relevant provisions that provide for such right. Montenegro believes that these provisions resolve the issue, raised by a Member, related to ability of natural persons to deal in wholesale.
