## REGIONAL DIALOGUE ON WTO ACCESSIONS FOR T HE GREATER HORN OF A FRICA

NAIROBI OUTCOME: FOS TERING SYNERGIES AND COHERENCE BETWEEN REGIONAL INTEGRATION AND THE MULTILATERAL TRADING SYSTEM THROUGH WTO A CCESSIONS

Nairobi, Kenya , 28-30 August 2017

The following communication, dated 1 September 2017, addressed to the Director -General , is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Kenya .

I ha ve the honour to inform you that the Regional Dialogue on WTO Accessions for the Greater Horn of Africa was successfully held on 28 -30 August 2017 in Nairobi, Kenya.

The discussions at the Regional Dialo gue enabled participants to engage in informative and interactive discussions on WTO accession reforms and regional integration including on experiences form ongoing, as well as concluded African accessions.

The Dialogue also invited acceding governments in the region, Comoros, Ethiopia, Somalia and the Sudan to provide participants on the state of play in their accession processes, and to present their nee ds for technical assistance and capacity building. The Dialogue also provided a useful platform for exchanges on available support and appealed to the development partners present to step up their support for the accession processes in the region.

All participants welcomed the recent progress registered in the accessions of Comoros, Ethiopia, Somalia an d the Sudan, and, in particular, pledged their full support for the conclusion of the accession of Comoros by the Eleventh WTO Min isterial Conference. All participants also expressed their full support to South Sudan for its intention to submit an applica tion for accession to the WTO in the very near future.
