The list of extremely dangerous animal diseases for which mandatory removal and destruction of the animals, products and raw materials of animal origin specially dangerous for the health of animals and human are required

Extremely dangerous infectious animal diseases for which it is necessary to remove sick animals, products and the raw of animal origin being particularly dangerous for the health of animals and human - to be incinerated:

Diseases common to several types of animals - brucellosis, rabies, anthrax, tularemia, FMD.

Diseases of the cattle - cattle plague, blackleg, malignant edema, spongiform encephalopathy.

Horse sickness - glanders, epizootic lymphangitis, African plague-hoofed.

Diseases of the of sheep and goats - slow diseases (scrapie, Maeda-visna, adenomotoz, smallpox, plague of small ruminants, brucellosis).

Diseases of the camels - the plague of camels.

Diseases of swine - African swine fever.

Avian diseases - plague of birds, bird cholera, and highly pathogenic avian influenza.

Diseases of dogs and cats - dogs and cats leptospirosis, microsporidia of the cats.

Diseases of swine - classical swine fever, erysipelas, vesicular disease, Teschen disease, transmissible gastroenteritis, African swine fever (exotic disease), influenza.

Avian diseases - infectious laryngotracheitis, Newcastle disease, Marek's disease, Gumboro disease, fowl pox, avian ornithosis, a respiratory mycoplasmosis, highly pathogenic avian influenza.

Diseases of fur-bearing animals and rabbits - a viral haemorrhagic disease of rabbits, myxomatosis.

Diseases of dogs and cats - distemper.

Diseases of fish - carp hemorrhagic septicemia, opisthorchiasis.

Bee diseases - varroaosis, askoferoz.
