Decision on the Organization of Operation of the Technical Barriers to Trade Enquiry Point

- x Pursuant to Prime Minister's Deer on the Organization of the National Authority for Science and Technogly No.444/PM, dated 24 December 2007.
- x Pursuant to Proposal of the DepartmentIntellectual Property, Standards and Metrology No.150, dated 16 June 2011.

The Minister to the Prime Minister's Office
Head of the National Authority for Science and Technology issues a regulation:

Section I General Provisions

Article 1. Objectives

This regulation establishes a Technical Beatsr to Trade Enquiry Point and provides procedures and authorities for information istinguamong relevant sectors at the central and local levels in order to respond effectivelyquoestions from domestic and foreign individuals and organizations, and to provible ormation with regard to and ards, technical regulations and conformity assessment.

By increasing transparency and access to regulatory and technical information, the effective operation of the TBT Enquiry Point willimprove the business environment and competitiveness in the Lao economy and will proben exports and imports. This regulation will also ensure that the baPDR complies with international agreements and treaties, specifically the requirements of the Worldade Organization's Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade.

Section III Rights and Duties of the TBT Enquiry Point

Article 5. Rights of the TBT Enquiry Point

The TBT Enquiry Point shallave the following rights:

- 1) To coordinate with central and locadovernment agencies and other relevant organizations to provide information and documents, and receive and answer questions from domestic and internation pairties regarding all national and local standards, technical regulations around formity assessemt procedures;
- 2) To participate in meetings, seminars, **rtinaigs** and dissemination activities that are related to TBT enquiry analytification activities;
- 3) To report on problems involving the EngulPoint to its higher level; and,
- 4) To coordinate with the SPS-TBT Notifitian Unit to seek funding and technical assistance from WTO members in ordeimtorove its operation and coordination.

Article 6. Duties of the TBT Enquiry Point

The TBT Enquiry Point heathe following duties:

- 1) Receive and respond within a reasonableetton all enquiries from domestic and foreign individuals and organizations regarding the following:
 - a) Any technical regulation, standard **ont**ormity assessment procedure proposed or enacted in the Lao PDR;
 - b) The membership and participation of the PDR in interrtainal, regional and bilateral standardizing bodies conformity assessment systs, mutual recognition agreements, and reasonable information the provisions of such international and regional systems and arrangements for which Laos is a member; and,
 - c) The location and availability of notices published pursuant to this regulation, or the provision of information as to whe such information can be obtained.
- 2) Coordinate effectively with the SPS-TBNotification Unit, the TBT Contact Points, the SPS Enquiry Point and othdevrent organizations carry out the duties of the TBT Enquiry Point and to support the SPS-TBT Notification Unit to respond to WTO notifications.
- 3) Develop and maintain a database forrellevant legislation and materials on the areas listed in section (1) of this Articlserving as a research library for TBT-related materials by providing up-to-datemprehensive information in one central location and making documents available the public for consultation or reproduction, both in terms of hard and scopies and on a website. A reasonable service charge can be applied to coveral courses for the material being supplied.

Section IV

Establishment of TBT Contact Points

Article 7. TBT Contact Points at the Central and Local Levels.

Relevant central and local government agenaires responsible to establish a contact point and assign staff to coordinate with the TTE nquiry Point and SPS-TBT Notification Unit regarding the preparation, adiopn and implementation of stellards, technical regulations, and conformity assessment procedures on a tibrasis as defined in Article 3 of the Decree on the Notification and Enquiry of Trade Rieda Information of the Lao PDR, No. 363/PM, dated 19 August 2010.

Relevant central and local goverent sectors are as follows:

- 1) Industry and Commerce sector;
- 2) Water Resource and Environment sector;
- 3) Agriculture and Forestry sector;
- 4) Energy and Mining sector;
- 5) Public Works and Transportation sector;
- 6) Post and Telecommunication sector;
- 7) Public Health sector; and,
- 8) other relevant sectors shall be responsible cooperating with the TBT Enquiry Point to answer questions and provide reant materials and information.

Article 8. Rights and Duties of Contact Points at Central and Local Levels
