Part III Structure, Rights and Obligations of Products

<u>Article 5:</u> As the permit to construct a factory is obtained from the relevant sector, the products require the following conditions:

Individuals producing foodstuff must be in possession of a health certificate delivered by

Article 14:

It is forbidden to use narcotic drugs and psychotic substances in food and drinks (such as: marijuana, caffeine, etc).

Article 15:

Poisonous materials are forbidden in drinks (such as: formanderite, flint, and insecticide).

Part VI Measures Against Producers

Article 16:

Any organization / individual transgressing these provision will be criticized; warned, penalized or prosecuted as provided by the laws.

<u>Part VII</u> Organization and Implementation

Article 17:

All food production units must strictly abide by these provisions.

Article 18:

These provisions on food product quality control are effective from the day they are approved and promulgated by the Prime Minister.
