

The Liberian Negotiating Team led by Minister Axel Addy, the Chief Negotiaissin Geneva for the 3rd Cycle of WP Meetings Bilateral track All bilateral market access agreement between Liberia and 6 Signatory Membersave been concluded. Kazakhstan

On Monday, 27 July 2015, the WTO General Council would consider for formal adoption the Report of the Working Party on the Accession of the Republic of Kazakhstan document WT/ACC/KAZ/93, together with the two addenda containing the Goods and Services Schedule Thiswould be the first agenda item of the upcoming General Council.

Belarus The Delegation of Belarus is in contact with the Secretariat on the technical basis for the esumption of its Accession Working Party, following the conclusion of the Working Party on the Accession of Kazakhstan in June.

Bahamas: The Bahamas had signalled its intent tosteart its Accession negotiations. Recently, Nassau had submitted t Negotiating Inputs, which included: (i) its Factual Summar (ii) an updated Legislative Action Plan, and, (iii) three piec of legislation (the Value Added Tax Act 2014; Value Adde Tax Regulations 2014; and Protection of Revenue Orde The Secretariat was process the inputs and would provide Nassau with a feedback on the substance of th submission with the overall purpose of faitating the Accession. The submitted inputswould be circulated as soon as the processing tabeen completed in accordance with WTO standards. Athis stagethe next meeting of the Working Party meetingcould be envisagedin the second half of November.
