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The implementation of the presentegulations, on the other hand, will provide the national industry with othervices as the Directorate will guide it to the best methods of qualityntrol, assist it in solving quality related problems and urge it to complete technical capacities. Also the implementation of the regulations will create a competitive atmosphere that will pave the way to complian with the standard Specifications.

It is hoped that the implementation of these Regulations will result in consumer protection as well as provision of services to both the manufacturer and merchant equally and hence, the development of the national economy in all aspects.

PART ONE THE OMANI QUALITY MARK

DEFINITIONS

The following wordings shall have the meanings assigned to them hereunder wherever they appeathis section of the regulations:

1. THE MINISTRY:

Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

2. THE DIRECTORATE:

The Directorate General of Spifecations and Measurements

3. COMMODITY:

The Final product to which this paof the Regulations applies

4. ESTABLISHMENT:

Any factory or production unit that roduces the committed whereon the Mark will be put.

5. THE OMANI QUALITY MARK (THE MARK):

A mark accredited by the Ministrynd illustrated by figure (1) attached hereto. It is a mark that indicates quality of the commodity holding it and implies the guarantee of the elistationent of the compliance of such Commodity with its respective standard

6. THE COMMODITY STANDARD:

The Omani Standard for the Comnitodor any standard accredited by the Directorate in case there is **O**mani standard for the commodity.

7. QUALITY CONTROL PLAN:

A plan for Quality Control agreed by the Directorate and the establishment in order to ensure thompliance of the commodity with its respective standard.

8. PRE-LICENSE ASSESSMENT:

A study conducted by the Directorate **tofe** application form for the license to use the Mark, general **tricar**lars and the enclosures submitted by the establishment after completiting relevant forms and the payment of the Specified charges (Forms No (1) and (2)).

9. THE INSPECTOR:

A representative charged by the Dimerate with the performance of the inspection Mark set forth in this Part of the Regulations.

10. INSPECTION:

All activities including sampling, measement, examination, testing, specifying the characteristics of them modity and comparing them with the requirements specified in themsdards to know the extent of its compliance with such specifications.

11. THE PRE-LICENSE INSPECTION:

A preliminary inspection conducted the Directorate's Inspectors the establishment applying for the license

Procedures for Obtaining the License to use the Mark

Article (6):

To obtain the license to use the Matthe establishment shall follow the following procedures:

- 1. The establishment shall apply to the diense to use the Mark according to Form (1) attach hereto, pay the pre-license assessment charges and promise to the present Regulations.
- 2. The establishment shall submit separate application for each commodity it produces and intends to put the Mark thereon.
- 3. The establishment shall provide the required informations in Form No. (2) enclosed herewith

Procedures for Granting the License to use the Mark

Article (7):

If the establishment meets the conditise provided for in articles (5) and (6) the Directorate shall act as follows:

1. Pre-license assessment:

Study the application for the licensee use the Mark (Form No. 1) the data provided by the establishment (Follow 2) and any other enclosures after the payment of the feepecified in article (9).

2. Pre-license inspection

- 2.1 Visit the establishment to conductethechnical studies such as the testing and examination facilities vailable and the quality control methods followed during the manufacturing processes.
- 2.2 Take random samples of the commodity beto marked to test them in the Directorate's laboratories or anyther laboratories accredited by the Directorate to ensure that the matter conform to their respective standards.
 - 2.3 Prepare a pre-license inspectioport according to Form No. (3).

3. Preparation of Quality Control Plan:

According to the pre-license insplient report, the Directorate and the establishment shall agree on a quadiontrol plan to be adopted by the establishment in order to guatee the continuous production of commodities conforming to the state of the state o

4. Granting the establishment the license to use the Mark:

The establishment shall be licensteduse the Mark by the Directorate after it meets all the conditions stipudatin this part of the Regulations. The establishment shall then be rietiff in writing on Form No. (4). The license- Form No. (5)-shall be valfor a period of one calendar year, annually renewable at the request the establishment that should be submitted, at least two months prior the expiry date of the previous license.

5. Periodic Inspection:

The Directorate shall in sept the establishment tensed to use the Mark periodically not less than three times year without prior notification, the inspection will include the following:

- 5.1 Examine the quality control records and the results of the tests and verify the commitment of the establishent to the agreed quality control plan.
- 5.2 Examine the records of the measurement and testing apparatus, verify their accuracy as well as the innual calibration and accuracy.
- 5.3 Draw random samples of the comodities bearing the Mark in the presence of the person in chargethine establishment in order to test them and ensure that they conform their respective standard (Form No. 6).
- 5.4 Prepare a report on each perioritispection on (Form No. 7)
- 6. The Directorate may take samples of the commodities carrying the Mark directly from the market to sethem and make sure of their conformity to the relevant standards.
- 7. The Directorate shall consider the complaints raised by consumers as regard the commodities carryingetMark and verify them.

8. In case the Directorate finds out that the commodities bearing the Mark do not conform to the relevastandard, the general provisions stipulated in this part of the gelations shall be applied to the establishment.

Responsibility of the Establishment after Obtaining the License to use the Mark

Article (8):

The establishment after obtaining them to use the Mark shall be responsible for the following:

- 1. To affix the Mark in the maner and method approved by the Directorate.
- To abide by the quality control planraged on with the Directorate so as
 to guarantee continuos conformaty the marked commodity to the
 relevant standard.
- 3. To record testing results in formsproved by the Directorate and keep them in a way that facilitate tir inspection and perusal by the Directorate inspectors at any time.
- 4. To carry out periodic, comprehensive xamination and calibration of all the testing and measuring apparatus.
- 5. To submit a bi-annual report to the Directorate stating the production quantity of the marked commodity well as the production quantity of the non-conforming, unmarked committees and the way of disposing thereof. The said report shall alistoclude the average commodity testing results during the said six months period.
- 6. The Quality Mark on any commoditischall be deemed a guarantee from the establishment of the quality of sucommodity and its conformity to the relevant standard. The establishmentall be held fully responsible if it breaches this part of the regulations.

The cost of licensing the use of the Mark

Article (9):

The establishment shall pay the followgicharges before it is granted the license to use the Mark:

1. Pre-license assessment charges :

A non-refundable sum (R.O. 50) Fiftyials Omani, paid once for each commodity bearing the Mark.

2. Pre-license inspection charges which include:

- 2.1 The cost of travel or transport tickets.
- 2.2 Allowances for the inspectors, as follows:
 - a. The sum of (R.O 20) twen Rials Omani as a dn subsistance for one inspection within the Governorate of Muscat.
 - b. The sum of (R.O 40) Rials Omani forts a daily subsistance for one inspectors outside the Govenorate Woofscat within a distance less than (300) kilometers.
 - c. The sum of (60 R.O) Rials Omasixty as a daily subsistance Allowance for one inspector outsithee Governorate of Muscat to a distance exceeding (300) km.
- 2.3 The cost of testing the samplesta during the pre-license inspection according to the specified fees (pls/sipping charges in case the test is to be conducted abroad).

3. The cost of licensing the use of the Mark:

(0.15%) one and a halfer thousand of the anniusales value of the commodity bearing the Mark making second to the commodity achieving the biggest sales as indecal to the final accounts certified by a chartered accountant to the minimum of (R.O 750) Rials Omani Seven hundred and fifty and the maximum (R.O 1500) one thousand five and hundred Omani Rials.
- c. (R.O 750) Rials Omani Seven hundred and fifty for eather commodity ranking after the first and second commedities.
- 4. Assessment, in the first year ofagting the Mark shall be according to the annual average of the actualesa of the commodity bearing the Mark in the last two years.
- 5. The charges paid by the distanment are non-refundable.

Suspension and Cancellation of the license to use the Mark

Article (10):

- 1. The license to use the Mark shall suspended in case of non-abidance of the establishment by the provisions for forth in this part of the Regulations or if it produces commodities non-conforming to the relevant standard. However ther to reduce the relevant standard to redress the suspension reasons.
 - 2. The suspension period shall not affect

- 5. If the establishment does not abide the provisions of the regulations the Directorate shall suspd the license to usbe Mark and notify the establishment immediately, so that the stablishment may redress it. If the Directorate make surthat the establishment is unable to continue producing commodities conforming to the evant standards or to abide by the provisions of the present restrictions, the Directorate shall have the right to cancel the license and notifie establishment to this effect in writing. The Directorate mayannounce such cancellation in the media.
- 6. The Directorate, in coordination with the Government agencies, shall start proceedings against the existation ent holding a license to use the Mark if such Mark is borne by commodities non-conforming to the relevant standards.
- 7. The establishment whose licenses haven suspended may submit an application to withraw suspension order for the license after the disappearance of the suspension or as However the suspension period shall not affect the expiry of the license.
- 8. The establishment who licensiss cancelled may submit a new application for a license to use the thank after it rectify the cancellation reasons. The establishment shall isotart using the Mark unless it receives a written notification to this effect.
- 9. The establishment which uses the Mark without having obtained a license from the Directorator uses the Mark initropy of the issue of a decision suspending the license or canceling it, or announces falsely in the media that it has obtained suotrelise, shall be subjected to the penalize provided for in article 4) of Royal Decree 1/1978 without prejudice to any other severer pleaner provided for in any other law.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

ARTICLE (12):

This part of the regulations shall apply the establishments that apply to the Directorate for a certifate of conformity for specific dispatch. The establishment may apply for the certifite of conformity to the standards of the country to which the dispatch is being exported.

ARTICLE (13):

The establishment shall be fully pressible for accuracy of the data it provides for the Directorate and thereditorate shall have the right to take any actions it deems approprian case of any violations.

Conditions for Granting the Certificate of conformity

ARTICLE (14):

The Directorate shall grant the estistbornent, at its request, a certificate of conformity for a shipment of certain commodity to certify its conforming to the relevant standard ject to the following conditions:

- 1. Existence of a standard perting to the relevant commodity.
- 2. The establishment is officially regested and authorized to deal in the relevant commodity according to the prevailing in the Sultanate.
- 3. The establishment should provide **Directorate** with any data required by the Directorate in relation to th

The Procedures for Obtaining the Certificate of Conformity

ARTICLE (15):

The establishment applying for a Cectifte of Conformity shall submit to the Directorate a seperate application for each specific shipment of the commodity. It must provide accurate the data required according to Forms No. (8) and, (9) and underto the accuracy of such data.

ARTICLE (16):

To grant the Certificate of Coonfmity, the Directorate shall:

- 1. Take samples of the shipment to beamined and tested according to its respective standard.
- 2. Study the examination and test results mpare them with the respective standard and make a report thereon.
- 3. The Certificate of Conformity (Formlo. "10") shall be granted to the establishment after the payment of the granted in article (17) if the results of examining and testithe sample taken from the shipment prove that it conforms to its respective standard.
- 4. The establishment shall be notifi**ed**writing in case of non-conformity, provided that the reasons of such non-conformity shall be given.

The Cost of Issuing the Certificate of Conformity

ARTICLE (17):

The establishment on applying for a certificate of conformity for a specific dispatch of ctain commodity shall pay the following charges:

- 1. Inspection charges , including:
- 1.1 Cost of travel or transport tickets.

- 1.2 Inspectors allowances as follows:
 - a. (O.R. 20) twenty Rials Omani as sistance allowance for one inspector within the Governorate of Muscat.
 - b. (R.O. 40) forty Rials Omani as subtains a allowance for one inspector outside the Governorate of Mustata distance less than 300 k.m.
 - c. (R.O. 60) Sixty Rials Omani as subtaisce allowance for one inspector outside the Governorate of Muscatta distance more than 300 km.
- 2. Charges for testing the samples traktering the inspection according to the specified fees (plus shipping others in case the test is to be conducted abroad).
- 3. Cost of issuing the certificate oborformity: (R.O. 10) Rials Omani ten
- 4. Charges paid by the establishment are non-refundable

General Provisions

ARTICLE (18):

- 1. The establishment that obtains a cieraife of conformity for a certain commodity shall not advertize suchmmodity except after the approval of the Directorate of the widing of the announcement.
- The Directorate shall have the rightdemand any certificates or reports on the tests conducted during theodurction stages of the relevant commodity.
- 3. The Directorate may keep sometble samples taken from the shipment for not more than three months at establishment shall not have the right of objection to the testingnd examination soults conducted on such samples.
