- Longcycle ofconflicts
- High costs in human losses infrastructure and economic capacities; displacement people, lasting impact future generations.
- War economiesactors have an interest in prolonging conflicts and iding reforms
- Root causes oconflicts are difficult to address
- Need for economic diversification, more privasector participation, market competition and ighting cronyism.
- MENA least integrated region in the world
