Given that only five LDCs joined the WTO in the patent years, we, in conjunction with other members, launched at the Ministerial Conference the negotiations on further streamlining accession procedures for LD and later made active responses to LDCs' requests on criterion of market assecommitments, special and differentiated treatment and technical assistance.
