VETERINARY LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF TAJIKISTAN

This Law shall determine the legal, sociality ganizational, financial and economic basis for veterinary and be aimed at ensuring vietery-sanitary and epizootic welfare, human protection from disease common to animalist and animalist and animalist and economic basis

- Quarantineshall mean legal regime providing thesterm of veterinary and administrative
 activities aimed at restriction and termation of economic ties and suspension of
 movement of goods subject to control by structe veterinary inspection bodies between
 epizootic focus, unfavorable area and territory of veterinary-sanitary welfare for the
 purpose of liquidation of epizootic focus of preventing the spread of disease;
- Veterinary rules (veterinary-sanitary ruless) all mean normative natilegal act providing procedure of taking veterinary measures do veterinary state approved by the authorized state veterinary body, which is doing on natural persons and legal entities carrying out veterinary activity;
- Special processing of animal products shadlam processing of products of animals with certain infectious diseases making them acceptable for the use by humans;
- Special slaughteshall mean slaughter ofinimals suffering from certain infectious disease in specially equived places and enterprises;
- Epizootic sourceshall mean the limited territory or premises where the sources of infectious agents, transfer factors an idnates susceptive to diseases are located:
- Veterinary drugs shall mean biological, vtate, chemical, pharmaceutical, disinfectant substances for disinsectization, disinfesta, diagnosis, prevention and treatment of animal diseases, as well as tools, equipmenterials and special means of transport;
- Genetic materials hall mean sperm, ovicell, animal **bry**os and pupae of bees, fertilized eggs, hatching eggs, cell culture, the problem genetic engineering technology, breeding material gametexygotes (cocoon, silkworm pupa);
- Plant products shall mean raw materials of plantigoin used by humans or animals as food:
- Meat products shall mean industrial produ**rots**de from animal flesh for use of humans and animals:
- Animal products hall mean raw material of animal origin and industrial products made thereof as well as the selection of aalmand industrial products made thereof;
- Trade in animal products shall mean protidurc; stocking, processing and marketing of animal products, any other way of transferpoolducts of animal orig with or without payment, export and import of animal products any other activity, which results in animal products being delivered other persons or consumers;
- Dairy products hall mean industrial products maderfr milk of animals for the use of humans and animals;
- Epizootological monitoring shall mean a steym of collecting quantitative data on occurrence of animal diseases, quality and ti-epizootic, veterniary-sanitary, zoohygienic measures, as well as thouality and safety of foodied and feed additives in order to identify their compliance with mantiday requirements and standards in a timely manner;
- Organoleptic examination shall mean the evaluation of quality of products through the senses;
- Extermination of animals and animal productional mean the slaughter, burning or burial of animals and products thereof suffering fromertain infectious diseases the list of which is determined by the authorized estateterinary body, which may be a factor of infection of animals and humans, as wellpassducts derived from healthy animals that do not meet veterinary sanitary requirements;

- Destruction of veterinary drugshall mean burning of veteringadrugs that do not meet the state standards or thoseouse time of use has expired;
- Infectious disease-problem arehall mean a territory where the epizootic focus is located:
- Biological stimulants shall mearall biologically active natural and synthetic substances;
- Veterinary objects subject to coult by state veterinary inspection all mean animals, gamete and somatic cells of animals, problem are materials of animal and plant origin, veterinary drugs, feed and feed ditives, microorganisms and their strains, apparatus, instruments, veterinary instrute transport means, containers, packaging material, territory, premises for the growing animals, production and processing, sores, slaughterhouses, warehouses for products and materials of animal origin, which may be factors of animal diseases transmission wals as the activity of legal entities and natural persons involved in cultivation, storatransport, storage, processing, sale and use of objects subject transmission to the state veterinary inspection body;
- Laboratory of veterinary sanitary examinatist mall mean legal entity or a specialized unit of a legal entity carry out veterinary-sanity rexamination of products and raw materials of animal and plant oinign markets and other sites;
- Animal wasteshall mean spoils and animal protuunsuitable for the use by humans;
- Veterinary drug testingshall meantesting of veterinarydrug under laboratory or production conditions in a manner prescribeyothe authorized state veterinary body for the purpose of determining its immunobiological, therapeutic and toxic properties and epidemiological effectiveness, lack of consences of effects and safety of the drug for possible use in veterinary practice;
- Veterinary-sanitary examinational mean verification of conformity of animal products and raw materials of animal origin with two inary standards, a set of organoleptic, biochemical, microbiological, parasitogical, toxicological and radiological examinations:
- Registration testing of veterinary drugsall means set of methods used in a manner provided by the authorized state veterinary body to determine the compliance of veterinary drugs with requirements of the veterinary related Tajikistan;
- Veterinary certificateshall mearan international document issued by the authorized state
 body at the state border of the exporting count of importing the compliance of exported
 goods with the requirements of importing count which states veterinary and sanitary
 safety of goods being under control of the test veterinary inspection, welfare of an area
 or production site;
- Certificate of conformityshall means document issued on the basis of the rules of the certification system, which confirms theompliance of certified products with requirements of normative acts;
- Certificationshall mean the process of confirmationthous fact of conformity of products with the set requirements;
- Disinfection shall mean removal or destruction ofeicatious agents in the environment, premises, transport, which is carried out withle help of veterinary drugs in a manner provided by the authorized state veterinary body;
- Veterinary activity shall mean an area of esponsibility of natual persons and legal entities aimed at protection of health of naturals, protection of humans from diseases

- common for both animals and humans, production based on veterinary-sanitary requirements;
- State Register of Veterinary Drughall mean the list of veterinary drugs passed the state registration and allowed for the production and use in the Republic of Tajikistan issued by the autrized state veterinary body;
- Strain of microorganism shall meargenetically homogeneous population of microorganisms with a stable speciforms and biological properties;
- Animals shall meaall mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, bees, fish and other animals that are kept in captivity those free-living in nature;
- Farm animala shall mean animals that arpst lost bred for the purpose of production of animal products;
- Domestic animals (pets)hall mean animals and birds kept at home for non-commercial purposes;
- Veterinary documentshall mean veterinary-sanitary reclusion, veterinary certificate, warrant, reference issued by vietary inspectors for the items subject to state veterinary inspection;
- Veterinary measure (sworks and services) hall mean a set of anti-epizootic, veterinary sanitary procedures aimed at preventione or ferging, spread or liquidation of animal diseases, including their prevention, treatmost diagnosis, neutralistion (disinfection) seizure and elimination of animals affective infectious diseases, which constitute a

- Approval of regulations of vettenary-sanitary laboratories;
- Approval of rules of markig, certification and types of individual animal passports;
- Protection of population health fromseiase common to animals and humans;
- Approval of procedure (methods, techniquess) carrying out veerinary-sanitary examination;
- Approval of rules of submission efatistical veterinary reports;
- Protection of the territory of the Republic of Tajikistan form introduction of infections and spread of animal diseases quarantingments as well as import of products, which contain biological stimulants, antibioticts prmonal agents used for speeding up the growth and development of animals, products in given increased ration and genetically modified products, from the territory of the states or quarantine zones;
- Issuing of permissions for export, import atmainsit of goods subject to control of the state veterinary inspection with taking into account of epizootic situation;
- Control over veterinary-sanitary safety **p** foducts, processing, or tage, transportation and marketing of objects subject to cohorothe state veterinary inspection body;
- Development and approval of the mannetrensportation (movement) of goods subject to control of the stateeterinary inspection body;
- Veterinary-sanitary examination of productsdataw materials of animal and plant origin to ensure the state controler quality and their safety;
- Organization of testing and control over veterinary drugs, feed and feed additives, their registration testing as well as maintenance takes testing and submission to prove the provent and submissi
- Development, approval and submission tafget-oriented programs to prevent and liquidate the infectious animal diseases;
- Maintenance and carrying out epizootic monity of animal diseases, including wild animals:
- Maintenance of state procurement, transporta(idelivery) and use of veterinary drugs in a manner provided for in the normative alegal acts of the Republic of Tajikistan;
- Development and submission of republicanograms aimed at training of veterinary specialists, production of medicines for diagnogspreventive measures and treatment of animals, organization of scientific results of veterinary related problems;
- Monitoring the compliance of veterinary related normative and legal acts by local executive authorities and publidifficers, enterprises, agains, other organizations and economic entities irrespective of the imbordination and types of ownership, public associations, international organizations, zeitis of the Republic of Tajikistan, foreign citizens and person without zitinship, owners of animalism, oducts and raw materials of animal and plant origin;
- Organization of implementation of vetexiry-instructive work among the population;

- Participation in state commissions regiagd acceptance of live-stak facilities and organizations for manufacting, procurement (slaughter) of animals, processing of products and raw materials of animal origin;
- Organization of implementation and controver identification and registration of domestic animals, pets, products and raw ritalse of animal origin, including movement of animals;
- Presentation of the Republic of Tajikistanvieterinary related international organizations in a manner provided for in the legislation the Republic of Tajikistan as well as organization of the cooperation with them;
- Providing binding instructions on carrying outsti-epizootic and veterinary-sanitary measures to all entities subject to controllness state veterinary inspection irrespective of the type of ownership;
- Taking measures, if there are infectious sealises, aimed at elimination of animals, extermination or decontamination of producated raw materials of animal origin, special processing or utilization real determination of compensation procedure for damages incurred by the owner at the expense state budget or insurance companies;
- Prohibition of sale of products annimal origin, as well as pocessing of raw materials of animal and plant origin not meeting vertreamly and sanitary requirements, protective means, diagnosis and treatment of animals additives that doot meet the quality requirements until the situation is corrected, well as filing complaints related to violation to court:
- In case of incompliance of microorganism istravith its passport, storage procedure of microorganisms in veterinary laboratories, stifec-research institutes and enterprises to process the products and raw materials of ahimigin, suspension of their use and filing of a complaint to court;
- In case of violation of veterima legislation, issuing of aimstructions, order and making the appropriate decision;
- Taking measures aimed at minimization, intreinijunction or termination of the activity of enterprises, agencies, organizations authorized entities being under under ontrol of the state veterinary inspection, in case of infringentheof veterinary-saitary norms and rules which may threaten human life and health to cause other grave consequences and filing of a complaint to court;
- Establishment of a procedure of mainitarion (annulment) of quarantine within the territory of the Republic of Tajikistan, relevolaterritories, districts, cities, economic entities and entities carrying out other activate well as establishment of crossing points through state border of the Republic of Tissilian, determination of conditions for the implementation of quarantine, ther restrictive veterinary-sanitary measures and the list of infectious animal diseases for which threat antine is carried outlisposal of animals and (or) seizure of products animal origin, in a manner ovided for by the authorized body and by other normative and legals and the Republic of Tajikistan;
- Appointment and termination of appointment the ads of the orgaizations subordinated to the authorized veterinary body in accordance the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan;
- Imposing of administrative penalties;
- Exercising of other powers provided for in mattive and legal acts of the Republic of Tajikistan.

CHAPTER 2. STATE VETERNARY REGULATION

Article 5. Basic Principles the State Veterinary Related Policy

- 1. Veterinary related state **picy** shall be implemented by the authorized body of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 2. Veterinary related state policy shall based on the following principles:
- Ensuring the independence of **thete** veterinary supervision;
- Mandatory implementation of normative and leaguets adopted by the uthorized body of the Republic of Tajikistan by all state bostieenterprises, agencies, organizations irrespective of their administriace subordination and type of one rship as well as by all executive officers, citizenshal persons without citizenship;
- Ensuring state veterinary supervision of opturction, storage, processing and sale of objects subject to control of the veterinary inspection body;
- Ensuring state veterinary supervision of spartation of goods subject to control of the state veterinary inspection body togad, air, railway transport;
- Support of measures for promotion of stantel private sector trerinary services;
- Provide the authorized veterinary dyowith required financial resources;
- Observance of unity of interests of the state, legal entities and natural persons in the veterinary area;
- Determination of conditions for compensation of value of animals, products and raw materials of animal origin constituting dange human and animal health exempted and eliminated by the state veterinary instance in a manner provided by the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan;
- Approval, upon submission by the authorizated dy, of the list of infectious animal diseases, preventive measures, diagnosisliquidation of which is carried out at the expense of republican budget;
- Coordination of veterinary related activitien local executive government authorities and self-government bodies of communities and settlements;
- State support of scientific research development of new methods for diagnosis, preventive measures and treatment of animal disease;
- Ensuring transparency in the process defvelopment, adoption and application of veterinary-sanitary measures;
- Development of international terinary related cooperation.

Article 6. Development and Adoption Veterinary-Sanitary Measures

- 1. Veterinary-sanitary measures shall be adopted and developed based:
- To the extent required for protection be and health of humans and animals;
- Taking into account scientifiprinciples and available scittic data, international standards, guidelines and recommendations;
- On the assessment of risk to human anichahlife and healthrealized in accordance with strategies of sectorial ternational organizations;
- On the avoidance of arbitary and unjustified discrimination among countries with identical and similar conditions, including discrimination among local zonal territories and animal production sectors and zonal territoriand animal production sectors of other countries;

- 2. When assessing the threat to human anichaetnlife and health in the process of development and adoption of veterinary-samyitmeasures, the authorized body shall take into account the following:
- Scientific data, manufacturing ocess and methods of supervy control, selection and testing of samples, the existence of specific diseases, availability of zones (districts) free from infectious diseases or zones (districts) with low level of spread of infectious diseases, relevant conditions of environment, quarantine and other measures;
- Economic indicators, including the mination of losses in polarition and trade in case of penetration (occurrence), rooting aspered of infectious disease;
- Costs for carrying out control and **liiq**lation of infectious disease;
- Effectiveness and cost of other approaches aimed at risk minimization;
- 3. Upon availability of satisfactorscientific evidences for objetive evaluation of the threat or in case of emergency circumstances, the continued body shall have right to take interim veterinary-sanitary measures to ascent the available data, including data of sectoral international organitions and information on veterary-sanitary measures in other countries.
- 4. Veterinary-sanitary measures taken shall ibecompliance with veterinary-sanitary conditions of a region in which goods seedtj to veterinary-sateary examination had been manufactured or a region for whistench goods are intended. In the course of evaluation of veterinary-sanitary conditions authorized body shall also take into account animal health status in the Republic ajikiry cond14 Tc .3002 Tw [(i52 0 Tf veter)

- Set a deadline for submission opinions and carry outonsultations upon request of interested parties;
- 2. Notification on goods subject to the measure with the rational rational

Article 8. Providing the Information

The authorized body shall, **thu**gh single data center, provi**the** information, documents and data in accordance with internation acts related to the following:

- Proposed and adopted veterinary-sanitary measures;
- Measures of control, inspleion and certification of producted quarantine procedures;
- Procedures for assessment risk and methods of determiting of appropriate level of animal health protection ithe Republic of Tajikistan;
- Membership and participation in intermatial and regional meetings, animal health protection system, existence and contentbitateral and multilateral agreements and contracts:

Article 9. Equivalence of **Werinary-Sanitary Measures**

- 1. Veterinary-sanitary measures approved in other measures applied in the Republic of Tajikristá the authorized body establishes that measures applied in another country ensther protection of human and animal life and health equal to that required time Republic of Tajikistan or higher.
- 2. Decree on recognition of equivalency of veteriy-sanitary measures shall be published.

Article 10. Quality Standards of Veterity Activities, Works and Services

- 1. Quality standards of veterinary activities (works and services) shall be established in a manner provided by the authorized body as wellinternational standards recognized by Tajikistan and shall be binding on veterinærgencies, natural penss and legal entities carrying out veterinary related tempreneurial activity throughouthe Republic of Tajikistan.
- 2. Non-compliance with repulibran quality standards of veteriny activities (works, services) by entities carrying out veterinary activitmay serve as a ground for bringing to administrative and criminal responsibility, ringination of their activity or revocation of veterinary activity licenses in a manner elistated by the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 3. Control over compliance with republican quality insulards of veterinary activities (works and services) shall be carried obty the state authomed veterinary body of the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 11. Departmental Vettenary-Sanitary Services

1. Ministries, agencies, enterprises, institutionals other organizations whose activity is connected with animal management and breggedstorage and sale of their products, feed and drugs intended for diagnostics, preventine asures and treatment of animals may

maintain manufacturing veterinary servicethatir own expense w

 Control over keeping veterinary records and ounting and their submission in a manner provided for in the legislation the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 14. Principles of the Stateeterinary Supervision and Control

- 1. Procedures of the state veterinary suipsion and control shall be implemented:
 - Immediately, without any delay and dismination with regardto imported goods relative to similar domestic products;
 - Only on the basis of facts and information, in whare required for caying out procedure;
 - Providing the applicant with the informati about time limits for completion of the procedure, possible shortcomings of tapplication, stages and results of the proceedings;
 - Ensuring the protection of onfidential information;
 - By taking samples only the amount necessarycarrying out combl and certification procedures.
- 2. If changes in specification of products occurbs equent to the veineary inspection and control, the procedure of insption and control of the modelia products shall be performed to only to the extent necessary to determine the product meets the relevant requirements despite the changes.

Article 15. State Border and Transp State Veterinary Control

- 1. The state border and transport state vertexpi control body shall be established and performed for the purpose of preventing theeapl and introduction of animal infectious diseases, diseases common to animals and hsumsanvell as products of animal and plant origin not meeting veterinary-sanitary querements of the Replic of Tajikistan.
- 2. Work place of the state border and transportestaterinary control body shall be located at the customs zone.
- 3. Passage through the customs bordethe Republic of Tajikistarof goods being subject to the state veterinary inspection body shall be mitted only upon checking the compliance of goods with supporting veterinary documents specific cases, the sample or the copy of goods shall be taken for laboratory tests.
- 4. Customs clearance of goods sattijto control of the state terinary inspection body may be completed only upon the completion of such a control.
- 5. Import and transit of goods subopt to control of the state veterinary inspection from other epizootic problem-free countries through the **tery**i of the Republic shall be permitted in case of compliance with veterinary rulers darequirements set by the authorized body.
- 6. Transport means entered into the RepublicTajikistan from countries facing epizootic problems shall be subject to mandatorytitieation in accordance with the veterinary legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 7. Veterinary inspectors of veterinary inspecti**po**sts shall wear special veterinary uniform when performing their duties **at**ate border and transportation.
- 8. Natural persons and legal idents whose activities are connected with import (export and transit) of goods subject to control of the text veterinary inspection body shall reimburse for expenses associated with contitue of veterinary-sanitary exmination and disinfection to departments, posts and other origations and bodies of the sata/teterinary inspection at the state border and transportation to the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 21. Procedure for Performing Control ovactivity of Veterinary-Related Economic Entities

Control over the activity of economic entities; espective of the from of ownership and departmental subordination, shall be carried from the purpose of statcontrol over compliance with veterinary legislation in accordance with which with the Republic of Tjakistan on Control over Activity of Economic Entities in Republic of Tajikistan.

CHAPTER 4. VETERINARY FINANCING

Article 22. The Sources for Finaing of the Veterinary and Veterinary Supervision

Veterinary and veterinary surpression in the Republic of Tajikistan Financing shall be funded from the following sources:

- Budget funds of all levels;
- Target-oriented veterinary funds;
- Income from entrepreneurial activof veterinary organizations;
- Financing of veterinary-relatednovative projects by investors;
- Bank and other credits;
- Grant and humanitarian aidd charitable funds of natural persons and legal entities;
- Other sources not in violation of the dislation of the Repulse of Tajikistan.

Article 23. Budget-related Finaing of Veterinary of the Republic of Tajikistan

- The authorized body and its lowerganizational units shall benfided directly from the state budget.
- 2. Planning the expenditures formaining veterinary in the Republic of Tajikistan at the republic budget expense shall be implemented the single normative financial costs to implement veterinary activity, which shall betablished by the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan and shall be available in the penditure part of budget of all levels in a "Veterinary" section.

CHAPTER 5. VETERINARY-SANITARYREQUIREMNETS TO PREVENT ANIMAL DISEASES AND ENSURING SÆETY OF PRODUCTS OF ANIMAL ORIGIN

Article 24. Veterinary-sanitary requirements design and constrtion of facilities for production, processing and storage of ducts of animal origin.

1. The creation of more favorable conditions storage of animals and production, in terms of veterinary-sanitary, quality and safety of products of animal origin shall be taken into account when designing and consting livestock facilities, policy farms, poultry factories, dairies, meat processing plants, fish farms other facilities for for oduction, processing and storage of products of animal origin, farm(farm) production, production cooperatives, joint stock companies, associations, organizations precise process of eveloping the design

- standards for objects of vetexiry inspection, resolving the sides concerning their location and establishment of vetexiry-sanitary zones.
- 2. Provision of land for construction, approval design standards and design documentation for construction, reconstruction of objects subjection of veteriary-sanitary inspection as well as putting into operation of objects to an account the permitted only upon provision of veterinary anitary conclusions.

Article 25. Veterinary-sanitary Requirents to Keeping, Feeding and Watering of Animals, their Transportation or Driving

- 1. Feed, water and feed additives shall be safeafrimal health and all not contain animal growth-promoting stimulatorsincluding hormonal and other substances harmful for animals, environment and human exceeding thaximum permissible level.
- 2. Veterinary-sanitary safety and (or) harmlessnessandards for feed and feed additives and procedure of its certification shall be set bytevienary rules. Safetyand (or) harmlessness standards for feed and feed additives shall not differ from relevant rules set by international standards and normative documents set by value riorganizations the member of which is the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 3. Production and use of feed afreed additives for commercial purposes based on its intended purpose shall be permitted upon acquisition of the issued by the authorized body.
- 4. Feed and feed additives not meeting veterinary-sanitary requirements (not certified) shall be removed from production and use based on **the**siton of the authorized body or shall be used, by its owners, in accordance witherinary-sanitary conclusion.
- 5. Transportation and movement of animals shall be permitted only upon acquisition of veterinary supporting documents, with comptianof veterinary-sanity irrequirements set to prevent occurrence and spread of diseasters, ugh the routes agreed with competent authority. Transportation and movement (export) of animals from the territories of regions and cities infected by animaliseases shall be prohibited.

Article 26. Veterinary-Sanitary Requirements to Carry out Substant of Animals, Production, Processing, Storage, Transpation, Marketing of Meat, Meet Products, Milk and Dairy Products, Fish, Eggs, Caviar and Representations of Animal Origin.

- 1. Natural persons and legal entities engage slaughter of animals, production, processing, storage, transposition and marketing of meathd meat products, milk and dairy products, fish, eggs, caviand raw materials of animal origin shall carry out their activity on the basis of the toerinary-sanitary certification of their working conditions;
- 2. Veterinary-sanitary certification of woirling conditions shall be performed by the authorized body.
- 3. Natural persons and legal entities theoretis or responsible persons of public catering facilities shall be responsible for ensuring terinary-sanitary teted conditions for storage, production, processing meat and meat products ilk and dairy products, fish and fish products and eggs.

Article 27. Veterinary-Sanitary Requirements for **Met**ing of Animals, Poducts of Animal and Plant Origin in Trade Outlets

1. In the process of marketing taximals, products of animal and plant origin for the purpose of preventing the occurrence and spread of diseases common to animals and humans

- 4. Each animal shall, from the date of its birhave individual personal assport, which will accompany it up to the moment of its death (slaarghtwhich shall be subsequently filed in an archive in a set manner. The following parameters identifying an animal shall be described in passport: its indivial (personal) number, colorex, date of birth, breed. Also, the passport shall indicate: natofean animal, last name, first name, patronymic or name of its owner, address of animal owner, date aftsfer (sale) of an animal from one owner to another, numbers of aof sale and animal insurance acts. veterinary processing of the animals i.e. types of veterinary processing, date of performining reaction of an animal to processing, signature of veterinary aspecialist i.e. aperson by whom the processing had been carried out shall bendicated in passport.
- 5. Animal stamping shall allow determining its bode age, place of birth assell as for carrying out control over transportatio (movement) of animals by the state veterinary inspection bodies, its production and raw material significant out tally sheets and reports.

CHAPTER 6. ENSURING PROTECTION FROMANGEROUS ANIMAL DISEASES, FOOD POISONING COMMON TO ANIMALS AND HUMANS

Article 30. Liquidation of Epizotic Sources and Elimination Threat of Occurrence and Spread of Infectious Animal Diseases

1. For the purpose of liquidation of epizooticusces of highly dangerous animal diseases and elimination of threat of occurrence andesign of these diseases, the introduction of quarantine, seizure of animals, conduction of other veterinary senitary restrictive measures shall be possible in accordance the threat decision of local executive government bodies on the basis of proposals and instruction has a such 325 TD 0 705.9(n902 The bas6).

Article 31. Obligations of Natural Persons, Legal Entities and ficers of the Authorized Body to Liquidate Epizootic Sources of the Authorized Body to Liquid

- 1. Natural persons and legal entitie the owners of animals approached animal origin for the purpose of liquidation of epizootic sourcesint fectious animal diseases that shall be responsible for the following:
 - Fulfill the requirements of this Law as well as of decrees, instructions and veterinary sanitary conclusions of that are veterinary inspectors;
 - Carry out the established and additional veterinary-sanitary measures, including disinfection, desinsectionand deratization;
 Exterminate or transfer the animals havinfertious diseases to industrial processing.
 - Exterminate or transfer the animals havingentious diseases to industrial processing plants to be subjected special treatment.
- 2. The officers of the authorized body shall be possible to take epial anti-epizootic measures, provided for in this Law, to expect the liquidation of epizootic sources of infectious diseases.

Article 32. Veterinary-Sanitary Examition of Products of Animal Origin

- 1. Meat, milk, eggs, fish, products of beekeeping bether products of animal origin shall be subject to veterinary-sanitary examination for the purpose of determining the quality, establishing veterinary-sanitary safety appropriateness of these products as foodstuffs. Veterinary-sanitary examination of products animal origin shall be carried out by laboratories of the authorized body. Such laborates shall be responsible for quality and objectivity of the examination in accordance the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 2. Products of animal origin, found to be damquer as foodstuffs based on the results of veterinary-sanitary examinations, all, in accordance with three terinary-sanitary conclusion, be subject to neutralization (decontamination) based on the ustrial conditions, and shall be subject to processing or describion by the owners in order throe harm to humans, animals and the environment.
- 3. The marketing of foodstuffs of animal origithat were not subject veterinary-sanitary examination shall be prohibited accordance with established manner.

Article 33. Certification of Products of Animal Origin

Industrial products of animal origin, the good qualityd veterinary-sanitary safety of which is established based on the results exterinary-sanitary examination certified in an appropriate manner, officially approved by veterinary-sanitary nclusion, shall be subject to certification in accordance with the procedure established by law.

Article 34. Interaction of Departmental Veterinænitary Agencies, Public Officers, Agencies of the Authorized Body, Sanitary-Epidemiologi State Bodies and Emergency and Civil Defense Agencies

Departmental veterinary-sanitally dies, public officers agencies of the altorized body of the Republic of Tajikistan, the authorized body sanitary-epidemiological inspection and emergency and civil defense agency shall form, within their competences, continuous

interaction related to organitizan and management of activisiemimed at protection of the population from diseases and food poisonion on to animals and humans.

Article 35. Rights and Obligations of Natural Persons and Legal Entities when Carrying Out Diagnostics and Immorophylaxis

- 1. When carrying out activities of diagnostices dimmunoprophylaxis nated persons and legal entities shall have the following rights:
 - To select government and non-government vedevi organizations or natural persons or legal entities carrying outntrepreneurial veterinary related activity;
 - To conduct the fee-based diagnostics and contieve vaccination measures against animal diseases included in the list of diseases, diagnostics and specific preventive measures of which is to be carried out at the expertor the state budget fould legal entities and natural persons.
- 2. In the process of conducting immunoprophylaxistural persons and legantities shall be responsible for meeting requiments of veterinary insptors aimed at compulsory vaccination against animal diseasesesitated by epizootindications.
- 3. With regard to animals whose owners did netenthe requirements weterinary inspectors to subject these animals to compulsory vaccimate ferred to in paragraph 2 of this Article, their marketing, transportation or moving, slaughter and quotessing for meat and meat products, marketing (sale) of meat and meat ducts without fulfillment of veterinary-sanitary restrictions set by terminary legislation shall not be permitted. Owners of the animals failing to meetthis requirement, shall liable in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 4. When making animal insurance agreements insurance companies shall include the

Article 40. Veterinary Rlated Production Activity

- 1. Veterinary related production activity shallers the activity aimed at production of drugs intended for diagnostics, preventive measures treatment of animals, production of veterinary and veterinary-zoenthnical items and veterinary equipment.
- 2. Management of production and purchase doutgs intended for diagnostics, preventive measures and treatment of animals as well-production of veterinary and veterinary-zootechnical items and veterinary equipmentall be fulfilled in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 41. State Support of Verteary Related Production Activity

For the purpose of ensuring the zepotic welfare in the Republic of Tajikisatn the state support of veterinary industry and producti of drugs intended for diagritics, preventive measures and treatment of animals shall be littled within the framework of budget fiancing by attracting grants of international ganizations and special functor rendering services.

CHAPTER 8. FINAL PROVISIONS

Article 42. Settlement of Disputes Reted to Veterinary Related Activity

Disputes arising from veterinary related activityall be settled before the court in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 43. Liability for Violations of this Law

Natural persons and legal entities all be liable for violations of the Law in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Tajikistan.

Article 44. Repeal of the eterinary Law of the Republic of Tajikistan

The Veterinary Law of the Republic of Tajikas of December 28 2003 (Akhbori Majlisi Oli of the Republic of Tajikistan, 2003., No.12, altio 701; 2005., No.12, article 632; 2007, No.7, article 688) shall cease to be effective.

Article 45. The manner of Entering Into Force of this Law

This Law shall enter into foe upon its official publication.
