These Regulations are intended to implement the general provisions of Decree-Law No. 1/2012, of 1 February, on the exercise of Downstream Activities in Timor-Leste and establish the principles and conditions to be observed by entities that exercise Downstream Commercialization Activities, as defined in paragraph g) of Article 2 of Decree-Law No. 1/2012, of 1 February.

With the approval of this Regulation, the ANPM has the necessary legal instrument to efficiently administer and manage the registration, licensing, organization and operation of new and existing importers, exporters and traders of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants, thus ensuring a level of compliance that supports the development of Downstream Commercialization Activities in the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, in a safe and efficient manner.

Therefore, under the terms of paragraph c), of no. 2, of article 7 and paragraph f), of no. 1, of article 8 of Decree-Law no. 1/2012, of February 1st, the Director Council of ANPM approves the following Regulation:

1.

a)

- 1. All entities intending to engage in Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants Trading Activities must register with ANPM and obtain the corresponding License.
- 2. If the entities already registered and licensed by ANPM for the exercise of other Downstream Activities intend to exercise Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants Commercialization Activities, they shall request and obtain a specific and independent registration and License, except if the Commercialization Activities are considered merely complementary or in support of another Downstream Activity, in which case article 8, no. 2 of Decree-Law no. 1/2012, of February 1<sup>st</sup> shall apply.
- 1. The application for registration and licensing shall be made through the submission to ANPM of a Downstream Activities License Application Form, in accordance with the form included in Annex II to ANPM Regulation No. 1/2012, as amended by Regulation No. 2/2014, together with the submission to ANPM of the form included in Annex I to these Regulations. The Applicant shall indicate in the application, inter alia, the specific activity that it intends to perform, as set out in Annex I to this Regulation.
- 2. In addition to other information and documentation indicated in the Application Form for Downstream Activities Licenses, the Applicant of an Import or Export License shall, obligatorily, submit an Annual Plan of Commercialization Activities for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants for the first Year of operations, prepared in accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 8 of this Regulation.
- 3. When analyzing and/or reviewing the License Application, ANPM may require the Applicant to provide additional information and/or documentation not expressly provided for in Annex I to this Regulation and that is considered necessary to properly evaluate the application.
- 4. ANPM shall issue a determination on an application within ninety (90) days from the date it receives the last required document or information, informing the Applicant of the determination in writing, as well as the steps, procedures and period for their implementation.

- 5. Applications shall not be considered if:
  - a) it is foreseeable that the scheduled start-up date will exceed six (6) months;
  - b) the Applicant, any of its board members or employees have been punished for a very serious Administrative Infringement under any Downstream legislation or regulation of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste in the 5 (five) Years prior to filing the application.
- 1. If the application is approved, ANPM shall confirm the registration and licensing through the issuance of a License for Fuel, Biofuel and Lubricant Trading Activities.
- The Licenses issued by ANPM under the terms of these Regulations shall present the format established in Annex I to Decree-Law No. 1/2012, of February 1, relating to the Downstream Sector.

- 1. The Commercialization Activities of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants shall be carried out in facilities and infrastructures located in the Territory of Timor-Leste.
- 2. Workers assigned to Fuel, Biofuels and Lubricants Marketing Activities shall have an employment contract with the Licensee in one of the forms provided by the legislation of Timor-Leste, and foreign workers shall also have a valid work visa or residence permit.
- 3. The entities registered and licensed for the Commercialization of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants must have the necessary resources to exercise the respective licensed activity, namely, financial capacity, workers, equipment and necessary systems.
- 1. Together with the application referred to in Article 5 of this Regulation, and subsequently, until the 15th day of January of each year, the Importers or Exporters of Licensed Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants shall submit an "Annual Marketing Activity Plan for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants" to ANPM, according to the model included in Annex II to this Regulation.
- 2. The Annual Marketing Activity Plan for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants shall include, in particular, a field for the description of the activities that the Applicant or the Licensee intend to perform, as the case may be, the requirement to submit a business plan, the explanation of procedures to be followed and the documentation to be included in the plan.

for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants, there must be a correction mechanism that allows to reconcile the payment of the fee with the actual amount imported and exported, following the annual or quarterly audit of ANPM.

- 5. The fees shall be paid by the Licensee before the issuance or renewal of the License.
- 6. Failure to comply with the obligation to pay the fees shall result in the refusal to issue or renew, or cancellation of the License, as the case may be.
- 7. In case of extemporaneous renewal of a License, the fees shall be increased by 50%.
- 8. The transfer or alteration of the Commercialization License is subject to the payment of a fee corresponding to 50% of the fee.

Without prejudice to other obligations and requirements set forth in these Regulations, in Decree-Law No. 1/2012 of 1<sup>st</sup> February, and other rules and regulations applicable to the performance of their activities, Licensees shall, as applicable:

- a) Keep ANPM informed of the status of their scheduled activities and of any changes to their deadlines and details;
- b) Contract transportation services that comply with all national and international rules and standards, particularly with regard to the safety of persons and the environment;
- c) Comply with all laws and regulations in force in the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, namely with regard to the environment, Standards and Quality Specifications for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants, tax, customs and security;
- d) Pay the fees determined by ANPM under the present Regulation;
- e) Ensure that they employ in their operations personnel with the necessary experience to carry out Fuel, Biofuels and Lubricants Marketing Activities.

 The Licensees that perform Fuel, Biofuels and Lubricants Marketing Activities must cooperate fully with the ANPM Inspectors or any entity accredited by ANPM that participates in any inspection, namely answering all questions and submitting and/or delivering all

- Quarterly Reports and Annual Reports on Activities for Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants submitted to ANPM and any additional information referred to in Article 9.
- 3. All records shall be kept in one of the official languages of Timor-Leste and/or one of the working languages, except for the Quarterly Reports and Annual Reports on the Marketing of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants Activities, which shall always be prepared in the official language used in the form included in Annexes IV and V to this Regulation, respectively.
- 4. The documents shall be made available to the Inspection Division of ANPM upon request.
- 1. All Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants purchased outside the Territory of Timor-Leste and imported into the country may only be sold to the public or used after verification of a prior inspection confirming the type of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants and that their specifications

- b) Carrying out Commercialization Activities of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants in violation of the terms and conditions foreseen in the respective License;
- c) Transportation of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants to the Territory of Timor-Leste or foreign countries without compliance with the obligation to previously submit to ANPM a Transaction Authorization Application for Commercialization of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants, in accordance with the form included in Annex III;
- d) Import of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants into Timor-Leste without the Product Quality Certificate issued by a competent entity;
- e) Imports of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants to Timor-Leste that do not comply with the specifications set forth in the Standards and Specifications of Qualities of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants Regulation, without obtaining prior authorization from ANPM for that purpose under the same Regulation;
- f) Sale to the public of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants purchased outside the Territory of Timor-Leste and imported into the country without a prior inspection confirming the type of Fuel, Biofuels and Lubricants and that their specifications comply with the Regulation of Standards and Specifications of Qualities of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants; and
- g) Sale in Timor-Leste of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants intended for export and which do not comply with the applicable Fuel, Biofuels and Lubricant Quality Standards and Specifications.
- 5. The infractor that commits an infraction under the present Regulation may also be subject to accessory sanctions, as provided in Decree-Law No. 1/2012, of February 1.

- The entities that currently exercise Activities of Commercialization of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants have ninety (90) days from the publication of this Regulation to submit to ANPM a License Application for Downstream Activities and other documentation required under the terms of article 5 of this Regulation.
- The entities that on the date of entry into force of this Regulation exercise Activities of Commercialization of Fuels, Biofuels and Lubricants have a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days to conform their activities with the rules and requirements established in this Regulation.
