# RULES IMPLEMENTING THE LAYOUT-DESIGNS (TOPOGRAPHIES) OF INTE GRATED CIRCUITS ACT 2002

### (<u>Issued by the Minister in accordance</u> with Section 21 of the Act)

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## Regulations Implementing the Layout-Designs (Topographies) of Integrated Circuits Act 2002

These Rules are issued by the Ministeraccordance with Section 21 of the Act.

Short Title and Date of Operation

 These Regulations may be cited as the Layout-Designs (Topaghies) of Integrated Circuits Regulations 2002 and shall come into operation on

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Interpretation

- 2. In these Reguidans, unless the context otherwise requires,
  - (i) "Act" means the Layout-Designs (Topographies) of Integrated Circuits Act, 2002;
  - (ii) "Agent" means a Law Practitioner resident and practicing in Tonga representing the applicant
  - (iii) "Minister" means Minister for Labour, Commerce & Industries
  - (iv) "Registrar" means the Registrar for Industrial Property
  - (v) "Section" refers to the specified Section of the Act;
  - (vi) "Regulations" means these Regulations;
  - (vii) "Regulation" refers to the specified Rule of these Regulations.

Fees

3. The fees to be paid espect of matters arising under the Act or these Rules will be those specified in the Schedule of Fees Schedule I annexed to and forming part of these Regulations.

**Forms** 

- 4.(1) The forms referred in these Regulations are those set out in Schedule II annexed to and forming part of these Regulations.
- (2) Copies of the printed forms shall be furnished free of charge by the Registrar.
- (3) A requirement under these Regulations to use such a form is satisfied by the use either of a replica of

that form or of a formwhich is acceptable to the Registrar and contains the information required by the form set out in that Schedule.

- Language of Documents and Translations
- 5. Applications all be in the English language, and any document form ipart of an application or submitted to the Registrar pursuant to the Act or these Rules and which is in a language other than English shall be accompanied by an English translation.

Indication of Name, Address, Nationality 6.(1) Names matural persons shall be indicated by the person's family name and given name(s), the family

name being indicated before the given name(s); the names of legal entities shae indicated by their full, official designations.

- (2) Addresses shall be indicated in such a way as to satisfy the customary requirements for prompt postal delivery at the indicated ades and, in any case, shall consist of all the relevant administrative units, including the house number, afny; addresses shall also indicate telegraphiand telex addresses and facsimile and telephone numbers.
- (3) Nationality shall bendicated by the name of the State of which a person isnational; legal entities shall indicate the name of the State under whose laws they are constituted and their Registered Office.
- (4) Residence shall bedicated by the name of the State of which a person is a resident.
- 7.(1) A document prorting to be signed for or on behalf of a partrheips shall contain the names of all the partners in and shall be signed by all the or by any ptaer qualified to sign, ating that he signs on behalf of the partner pripe, or by any other person who satisfies the Registrar that is authorized to sign the document; a document purporting to be signed for or on behalf of a body corporate shall be signed by a director or by the secretary other principal officer of the body corporate, or by any other person who satisfies the Registrar that he is authorized to sign the document and shall bear the seal of the body corporate; a document purporting to be signed for or on behalf of an association of persons may be signed by any person
- (2) The Registrar may, whenever he deems it necessary, request evidence authorization to sign.

Signatures by Partnerships, Companies and Associations

#### Representation

- 8.(1) The appointment of an Agent shall be by a power of attorney which shall be signed by the applicant or, if there are more than one, by each applicant.
- (2) The power of attorney appointing an Agent shall be filed together with the application; if the appointment is not thus made and is not in accordance with Section 14 and paragorh (1), any procedural steps taken by the Law Practitioner, other than the filing of the application, shabe deemed not to have been taken.
- 9.(1) The applicatin for the registration of a layoutdesign shall breade on Form No. 1 and shall be signed

by each applicant.

- (2) The application shahdicate each applicant's name, address, nationality and residence.
- (3) Where the applicant the creator, the request shall contain a statement toatheffect, and, where he is not, it shall indicate each exator's name and address and be accompanied by the statement justifying the applicant's right to the registration of the layout-design.
- (4) The brief and precise designation of the layoutdesign shall consist of the title of the layout-design indicating the matter to which it relates or indicating the field to which the article in which it is intended to be incorporated, or has been incorporated, relates.
- (5) Where the applicatin was accompanied by a copy of the layout-design, the applicant shall file a drawing thereof within a period of one month.
- 10.(1) The applition may be withdrawn by written declaration submitted the Registrar and signed by each applicant.
- (2) The application fee **ah** not be refunded if the application is withdrawn.
- 11.(1) Upon reignet, the Registrar shall mark, on each document making up the application, the actual date of receipt and the application number consisting of the letters T, Ostroke, the letter LD,

stroke, the last two digits of the year in which the initial papers were received, stroke, and a five-digit number allotted in the sequential order in which applications are received where any corrections or other later filed documents received on different dates, the Registrar shall also their actual date of receipt in the appropriate place of the request for registration of the layoutlesign (Form No. 1).

- (2) The application number allotted under paragraph (1) shall be **qte**d in all subsequent communications concerning the application.
- 12.(1) The Resignar shall examine whether the application fulfills the requirements set out in Section 9(2).
- (2)(a) Whereath Registrar finds that the application did not athe time of receipt fulfill the requirements referred to paragraph (1), he shall invite the applicant to the the required correction.
- (b) The invitation to lie any correction shall be in writing; it shall specif the correction or corrections required and request that these be filed within two months from the date of the said invitation, together with the payment of the prescribed fee.
- (3) Once the Registraccords a filing date, he shall so notify the applicant in writing; if the application is treated asitfhad not been filed, under Section 9, the Registrar shaotify the applicant in writing, specifying the reasons.
- (4)(a) Where the conditionset out in Section 9 are not fulfilled, the Registrar shall reject the application and notify the applicant tating the reasons.
- (b) Where the Registrar finds that the conditions set out in Section 9 and theules pertaining thereto are not fulfilled, he shall invite the applicant, in writing, to file the required correction within two months from the date of the invitation, togeth with the payment of the prescribed fee; if the picant does not comply with the invitation to correct a deiency, or where, despite corrections submitted by the applicant, the Registrar is of the opinion that the saicbnditions are not fulfilled, he shall reject the applition and notify the applicant, in writing, stating the reasons.

- (5) Refusal of the application shall not affect its filing date which shall remain valid.
- (6) The Registrar shall notify the applicant, in writing, of his decision togrant or to refuse the application, and, in the case a decision to grant the application, he shall requeste applicant to pay the registration and publications within one month from the date of the notification.

Registration of Layout-Design; Publication of Reference Thereto; Issuance of Certificate

- 13.(1) Subject the payment of the registration and publica fee within the period prescribed in Rule 12(6)et Registrar shall register the layout-design in accordance with Section 10 and this Rule, publish a reference to the gistration and issue to the applicant a certifiate of registration.
- (2) The Registrar shadlot to each layout-design he registers a number in the sequential order of registration.
- (3) The registration a layout-design shall include, in addition to the articulars specified in Section 10, a copy or drawing thereof, and shall specify
  - (i) the name and address of the registered owner:
  - (ii) the name and address of the agent, if any;
  - (iii) the name and address of the creator, except where he has asked not to be named in the registration; and
  - (iv) the date of the first commercial exploitation, anywhere in the world, of the layout-design oan indication that such exploitation has not yet commenced.
- (4) The publication of the reference to the registration of a layout-diegn, under paragraph (1), shall contain the particulars specified in paragraph (3).
- (5) The certificate of **g**istration of a layout-design shall be issued on Form No. 2.
  - 14.(1) The Registschrall cause to be entered in the

register in respected fery layout-design, in addition to the information indicated in Rule 13(3),

- (a) the address for service;
- (b) the date on which the layout-design registration expired [or wasurrendered] or canceled;
- (c) any change in name or address, or any change in address for service or ownership in accordance with Rules 15 and 16, below;
- (d) the fact that a license contract has been concluded and recorded record rec
- 15.(1) The request, undection 12, for the recording of a change in owners of a layout-degn registered under the Act oran application therefore shall be made to the Registrar from No. 3 and shall be subject to payment of the prescribed fee.
- (2) The publication of the change in ownership shall specify
  - (i) the number of the application or registration concerned;
  - (ii) the filing date, the date, if any, of first commercial exploitation, anywhere in the world, and the date of registration;
  - (iii) the owner and the new owner; and
  - (iv) the nature of the change in ownership.
- (3) A license contract submitted for recordal under Section 12 shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.

Address for Service

- 16.(1) There shall be mished to the Registrar:
  - by every applicant for the registration of a layout-design, an address for service in Tonga for the purpose of his application, and
  - (ii) by every person (including the applicant for, or the owner of, a layout-design, as the case may be) concerned in any proceedings to which any of these Rules relate, an address for service in Tonga,

Changes in Ownership; License Contracts and the address so furnisher, where another address being an address in Tonga has been furnished in place thereof, that address shall treated for the purposes of that application or those proceedings, as appropriate, as the address of that applicator, as the case may be, of that person.

(2) Where an Agent has been appointed in accordance with Section 14 and Regulation 8, the address of the Agent shall purposes connected with the Act and these Rules, be treated as the address to which communications to the person or persons who appointed the Law Practitiner shall be transmitted.

**Excluded Days** 

17. When the lastydar doing any act or taking any proceeding falls on a day when the Registrar's Office is not open to the public forusiness, it shall be lawful to do the act or to take the proceeding on the day when the Registrar's Office is ext open for business.

Consultation of

18. Consultation to Register shall be subject to

persons, at least two weekstice, in writing, of the date and time of the hearing.

Service by Mail

22.(1) Any noticepalication or other document sent to the Registrar by mail shall be deemed to have been given, made or filed at the time when it would be delivered in the ordinary cosse of the mail. In proving such sending, it shall befsicient to prove that the letter containing such note, application or other document was properly addressed and sent by registered mail.

Extension of Time Limit

23.(1) The time **periods** prescribed by these Rules for doing any **acr** taking any proceeding thereunder, may be extended the Registrar if he thinks fit, upon such note to the parties and upon such terms as he may directed such extensions may be granted although the time or period for doing such act or taking such proceimed has already expired.

Directions as to Furnishing of Documents

24. At any stage **a**fy proceedings before the Registrar, **h**eay direct that such documents, information or evid**ee** as he may require be furnished within such period of time as he may fix.

Corrections of Irregularities

25. Anirregularity in procedure before the Registrar may be rectified, on such terms as he may direct.

Dispensation by the Registrar

26. Where, undeeste Regulations, any person is to do any act or thing, any document, or evidence, is required to be produced direct, and it is shown to the satisfaction of the Registretrat from any reasonable cause that person is unable to do that act or thing, or that that document or evidence cannot be produced or filed, the Registrar may, upon the production of such evidence and subject to such terms as he thinks fit, dispense with the doing of such act or thing, or the production or filing of such document or evidence.

Hours of Business

27. The Registrar's **D** fe shall be open to the public from Monday to Fridaryclusive, each week, between

29.(1) Anystatutory declaration affidavit filed under the Act orestee Regulations shall be made before

any officer authored by law in any part of Tonga to administer an oath for the purpose of any legal proceedings.

(2) Statutory declarations or affidavits made outside Tonga shall be mabefore a Consul or Notary Public.

Publication; Gazette

30.(1) Particulars of layout-designs of integrated circuits and other proceedings under the Act and any other information required to be published under the Act or these Regulations shall be publishedthe Gazette or in any other publication as directed by the Registrar.
