Distinguished guests,

Nairobi is not the end of the road, and we still have opportunities to preserve the Credibility of Multi-literal Trading system.

Myanmar has always been very supportive of the multilateral trading system. In this regard, despite our supply-side constraints, Myanmar has already sent the notification on the acceptance of the Protocol of Amendment to insert the WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement into Annex 1A of the WTO Agreement on 7 December.
