#### WTO Briefing room

- o Seating capacity: 250 people
- This room will not be available for NGOs to organize meetings or briefings. It is reserved for briefings by WTO Secretariat and Members.

#### Working area for NGOs

- o Seating capacity: 250 people
- This room will be equipped with a limited number of PCs and copiers, as well information screens

#### One big meeting room

- Seating capacity 250 people
- This room will be equipped with a sound system

#### Two big rooms

Seating capacity of 150 people

#### Four smaller rooms

o Seating capacity of 50 people
