#### **Explanatory Notes**

#### **Note on Funds from International Donors**

International donors play a key role in funding agricultural programmes in Afghanistan. This assistance is very important in improving the viability of the agricultural sector in Afghanistan. The aim of this note is to summarize for transparency purpose the type of activities that are funded by international donors. As it is our understanding that these external sources of funding should not be included in Supporting Tables DS:1-DS:9, the data in Domestic Support Tables exclude the funds provided by international donors.

The main Government body designing and implementing the agricultural policy in Afghanistan is the Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock (MAIL). We should note, however, that a significant portion of the funds provided by international donors for agriculture during recent years were directly incorporated into the Government Budget. The budget of MAIL consists of the operating budget and the development budget. The development budget is funded mainly by
