CONTEXT

The 100 th Session of the WTO's Committee on Trade and Development (CTD) will be held on 24 November 2016. This is a significant milestone for the multilateral trading system – and for the CTD, which serves as a focal point for consideration and coordination of development work in the WTO.

To mark this occasion, a half-day commemorativ e will be held in the morning of 24 November, prior to the start of the CTD's 100 th Session.

Since the establishment of the WTO, considerab le progress has been made in integrating developing countries into the multilateral trading system, and their share in world trade has seen a marked increase. Trade continues to be recognized by the international community as an
